




RIVA/Jettrim Seat Covers with or without Pull Tabs

Applications: All RIVA/Jettrim Seat Covers

Required Tools/ Materials:PartHeavy-duty Staple GunN/A3/8" Stainless Steel StaplesN/A

Before beginning installation determine whether or not your seat cover has "pulls". Pulls are plastic tabs that pull through the seat foam to make the cover better conform to the shape of the foam. See Figure 1 for an example of a cover with pulls. Turn your seat cover upside down and examine it to determine if it has pulls. Follow the instructions below for the correct cover type.

- INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS -

RIVA/ Jettrim Seat Covers with pulls

- 1. Remove stock seat cover completely.
- 2. You may have to separate foam from seat tray.
- 3. Waterproof seat foam with plastic. (trash bag works well)
- 4. Poke holes through foam where pull tabs go.
- 5. Align seat cover on seat.
- 6. Push tabs through holes in foam.
- 7. If you separated the foam from the tray place it back on the tray now.
- 8. Lay your RIVA/JETTRIM cover over the seat.
- 9. Find the center point in front of your seat. Match it to the center of your seat cover. Using your staple gun, apply 4 to 5 staples into what is called the "listing". The listing simply is the material that runs around the whole outside perimeter of you seat cover and where your staples are applied.
- 10. Move to the front corners of your seat and staple to secure each corner while keeping in mind the stretch factor.
- 11. Move to the rear of your seat and stretch your seat cover over the back. Stretching is very important, so take your time to insure proper installation.
- 12. After you have properly stretched your seat cover, secure it by stapling the center then the rear corners of your seat cover.
- 13. Move back to the front of your seat again, focusing on the wings (bottom front part of your seat). Stretch evenly from side to side and secure with staples.
- 14. Secure all of your excess material found in all corners. Just like wrapping a present.
- 15. Once all the corners are secure, everything else, with minimal stretching will fall into place.
- 16. Don't be afraid to use extra staples to secure your seat cover.

RIVA/Jettrim Seat covers without pulls.

- 1. Leave stock cover to insure dryness.
- 2. Lay your RIVA / Jettrim cover over the seat.
- 3. Find the center point at front of your seat. Match it to the center of your seat cover.
- 4. Using a staple gun, apply 4 to 5 staples into what is called the "listing" (The material that runs around the whole outside perimeter of you seat cover and where your staples are applied).
- 5. Move to the front corners of your seat and staple to secure each corner while keeping in mind the stretch factor.
- Move to the rear of your seat and stretch your seat cover over the back. Stretching is very important, so take your time to insure proper installation.
- 7. After you have properly stretched your seat cover, secure it by stapling the center and then the rear corners of your seat cover.
- Return to the front of your seat again, focusing on the wings (bottom front part of your seat).
 Stretch evenly from side to side and secure with staples.

- 10. Once the corners are secured everything else, with minimal stretching, will fall into place.
