

### - INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS -

Remove seat.

Remove under seat storage trays (2).

Remove screws (2) holding L side panel. Remove L side panel. (Figure 1)

Repeat procedure for R side panel.

Open front storage compartment lid to fully open position. Pull lid directly away from ski to remove lid from plastic hinge. (Figure 2)

Press in on center pin of plastic rivets with screwdriver or similar object and remove plastic rivets and storage tray.

Note: Do not push too far or center pin will fall into storage compartment. (Figure 3)

Remove bolts (6) holding front cover to ski. (Figures 4 and 5)



Remove bolts (6) holding steering cover. (Figure 6)

Release side catches and remove steering cover. (Figure 7)

Push front upper cover up and back to release and remove from ski. (Figure 8)



Lift up the nose of the front cover and block it in place. Tip: Use something soft, be careful not to scratch the ski.

Remove the nuts (4) two on each mirror and the plates, and remove mirrors. (Figure 9)

Remove rubber base from mirror. Two different length 6mm bolts are supplied with the block offs. The longer bolts (6x20 mm) and spacers go in the rear holes. The shorter bolts (6x16 mm) and spacers go in the front holes.

Assemble each bolt with a lock washer followed by a fender washer and spacer. (Figure 10)

Install bolt assemblies through front cover and rubber mirror base into supplied mirror block off. Note: longer bolts and spacers go into rear holes. Shorter bolts and spacers go into front holes. Apply red Loctite to bolts. Do not overtighten bolts. (Figure 11)

Replace parts previously removed to access mirror bolts reversing removal procedure.

Check bilge for tools, rags, etc. Run craft on a flush kit to check for proper operation.
